Parent Vote for Permission to Submit a Charter Application

Local school boards have the option to require nonprofit groups to demonstrate support from parents and guardians of a majority of students currently enrolled in a school in order to qualify to submit an application to convert the school into a charter school. This form provides the method by which you, as the parent or guardian of a child in a school eligible for conversion, can let your local school board know if you would like to allow the nonprofit group listed below to submit their application.

To indicate your desire to allow __Neville Charter Association to submit a charter application. please follow the instructions below. Do not complete this form if you do not want to grant the applicant permission to submit an application.

1. Only parents or guardians of students *currently enrolled* in the school may complete this form.

- 2. Only one form may be completed for each child attending the school.
- 3. Submit this form to the non-profit applicant according to the method and timeline that the non-profit applicant indicates.
