Thank you for your incredible hard work, dedication, and resilience in successfully completing the 2025–2026 school year.

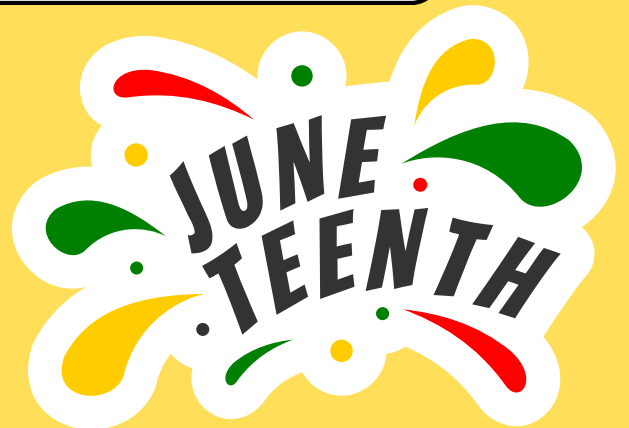

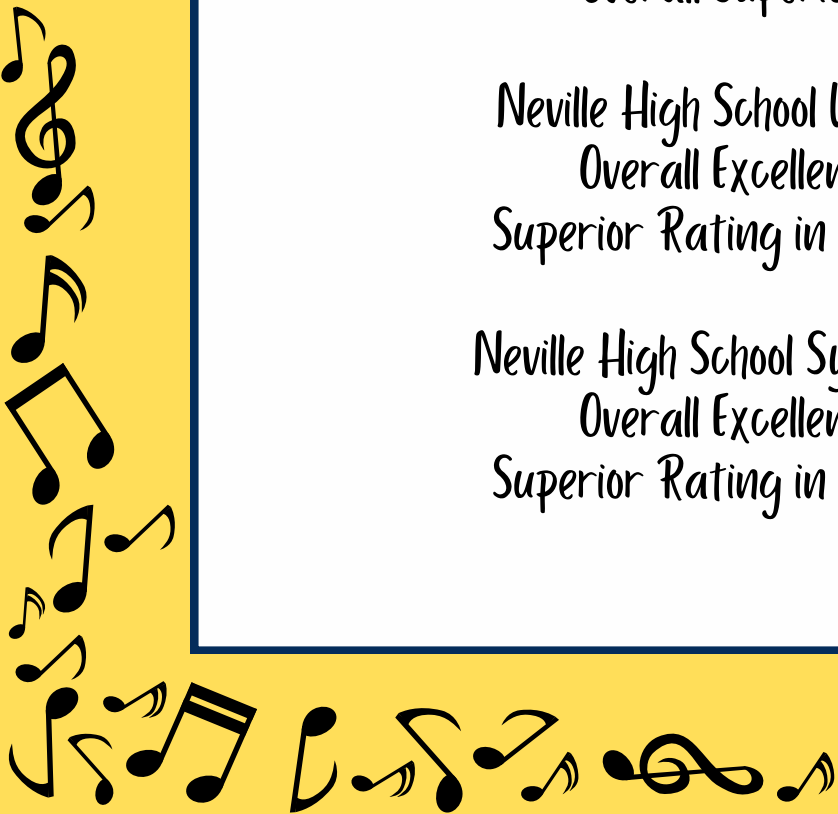

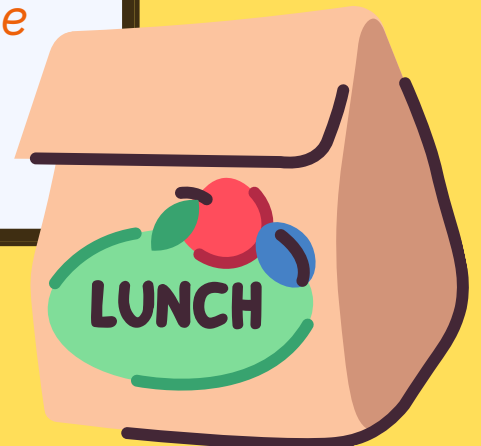
